Scramble Rules

Method of play and rules:

1. Play begins with each member of the group teeing off.
2. With the agreement of the other members of the group, the team captain decides which drive is the most desirable.
3. The other members of the group pick up their balls and proceed to the spot of the selected drive, where they will hit their second (or third, or fourth, etc. shot).
4. After the shot, all balls may be placed within one club length of the original ball. This may be done either to the side or backwards. Balls may not be placed closer to the hole.
5. In placing the ball, you may not change the condition of the shot. If the ball is in a hazard (e.g. sand trap, rough) all members of the team must play their shot from the trap or rough, respectively.
6. This procedure continues until the ball is in the hole.
7. On the putting green, **do not hole out a short putt if you have missed your first putt.** The first ball putted must count. Mark your ball and wait. If the second or third putt is better, mark that putt. Under no circumstances will there be any gimmies.
8. At the end of each hole, the score for the group is recorded on the card.
9. All scorecards must be kept accurately and per hole.
10. Each player on the team must contribute at least **two** tee shots per 18 holes. If only three members are on a team, **three** tee shots must be used per 18 holes. When recording your score on the card, you must input which player's tee shot was used on every hole. Also mark down which member of your team made the putt.
11. The maximum score allowed is a double-par. After that, simply pick up the balls and move on to the next hole.
12. In case of tiebreaker after 18 holes, playoff rules for winner will be based on golf course availability and/or agreement between applicable captains on tiebreaker procedures.



SNC Horseshoe Tournament Rules

Method of play and rules:

1. All court layout dimensions, playing equipment and scoring will follow the official rules sanctioned by the NHPA (National Horseshoe Pitchers Association of America).
2. Cancellation scoring will be used to keep score during the tournament.
3. Ringer: Ringers cancel each other. A ringer of one contestant shall cancel a ringer of another contestant and those shoes shall not score any points. Any uncanceled (live) ringers shall score 3 points.
4. Shoes in Count: A shoe in count (upright horseshoe length from the stake) shall score one point under the following conditions: If there are cancelled ringers and no live ringer, the closest shoe in count to the stake shall score one point. If there are no ringers, the closest shoe in count to the stake shall score one point. If the other shoe of the same contestant is the second closest shoe in count, it shall also score one point. If there is one uncanceled ringer and the other shoe of the scoring contestant is the closest shoe in count to the stake, it shall score one point (four points total).
5. On tournament day, there will be one scorekeeper per game. This score sheet shall be the official record of the game. Contestants are encouraged to pay close attention to the score at all times. If a question or discrepancy occurs regarding the score, the contestant(s) may approach the scorekeeper between innings to rectify the situation. This scorekeeper or other identified authority will also judge any discrepancy of which contestants shoes are closer to the stakes during the game. If discrepancies cannot be corrected to the satisfaction of all contestants, the tournament judge shall be called in to make the final decision.
6. Each team will be comprised of four pitchers. Each team will be selected into an eight team bracket that will be drawn on seeding night.
7. The Horseshoe Tournament will begin with your team dividing into two teams of two contestants. **(These teams must be determined before seeding)**. Your two teams will be matched against the other team in your bracket who will also divide their team into two teams of two contestants.
8. Please note that your "A" squad will match up with your opponents "A" squad along with "B" squad vs. "B" squad in your individual bracket. If both of your split squads win, you advance out of bracket. If one squad loses and the other wins, only the winning squad can participate in the tie breaker to advance to the next round. Also, the bottom team in the bracket will call the coin toss and be able to choose individual match ups within the bracket. There will again be a coin flip in case of a tie breaker.
9. Each game will be played to twenty-one points (First team to twenty-one, no need to win by two points). However, the skunk rule will be in effect. If any team scores eleven points before their opponent scores one point, the game is over. Final score would be (11-0).
10. The Sierra Nevada Athletic Commission will allow alcohol, smoking and chewing during this tournament event.



SNC Bowling Tournament Rules

Method of play and rules:

1. Teams will begin round one play based on Thursday night bracket seeding.
2. The teams that win in the first round will advance to the second round and either the title or consolation games via match play.
3. If two teams are tied at the end of 10 frames of bowling, the Captains from each team will bowl against each other frame by frame until there is a winner.

Overall Tournament Scoring Rules

1 st Place In An Individual Event.....	4 Points
2 nd Place In An Individual Event.....	3 Points
3 rd Place In An Individual Event.....	2 Points
4 th Place In An Individual Event.....	1 Point

Tiebreaker

If the day ends with a tie for first place in the overall tournament, a bowl-off will be implemented to determine the champion. Then, in order to determine the overall finish other than first, total points and then total bowling average will be used to rank teams.

Friday Night Bags Tournament

This will be the first year for a Friday Night Bags Tournament tentatively scheduled to take place in the infamous Picon Room. Similar to horseshoes, A and B squads will face off based on Thursday Night Seedings. Each team needs to ante up a \$100 entry fee. Winning team takes home \$800. This will be a one-and-done tournament with no consolation round.

Tournament Rules

Scoring

- Traditional 21: The game shall be played to the pre-determined number of twenty-one (21) points. The first player/team to reach (or exceed) that amount at the conclusion of a frame is the winner. Do not need to win by 2.
- Cancellation Scoring: The approved method of scoring for the sport of bags is “cancellation” scoring. In cancellation scoring, the points of one player cancel out the points of their opponent. Using this method, only one player/team can score in each frame.
- No bags shall be moved before the scoring is determined. If this decision is in doubt, a Designated Official shall be called to determine the scoring for the frame in question.

Doubles Play

- Team A competes against Team B – each team is comprised of two (2) people.
- Each team will stay in their designated lane for the whole game.

Seeded Tournaments

- The player/team with the higher seed has their choice of bag color.
- The player/team with the higher seed pitches first.
- In doubles play, the higher seeded team chooses one of the following options:
 - Choose lane assignments
 - Choose their opponent to pitch against (head-to-head)
 - If option #1 is selected, the higher seed chooses their lane and takes their positions in the Pitcher’s boxes, then the lower seeded team chooses their own Pitcher’s boxes to determine head-to-head match-ups.
 - If option #2 is selected, the lower seed chooses their lane and takes their positions in the Pitcher’s boxes, then the higher seeded team will choose their own Pitcher’s boxes to determine head-to-head match-ups.
 - If playing best 2 out of 3 matches, the First Pitch and Pre-Match options go to the higher seed in game #1 and to the lower seed in game #2. If a third game option return to the higher seed

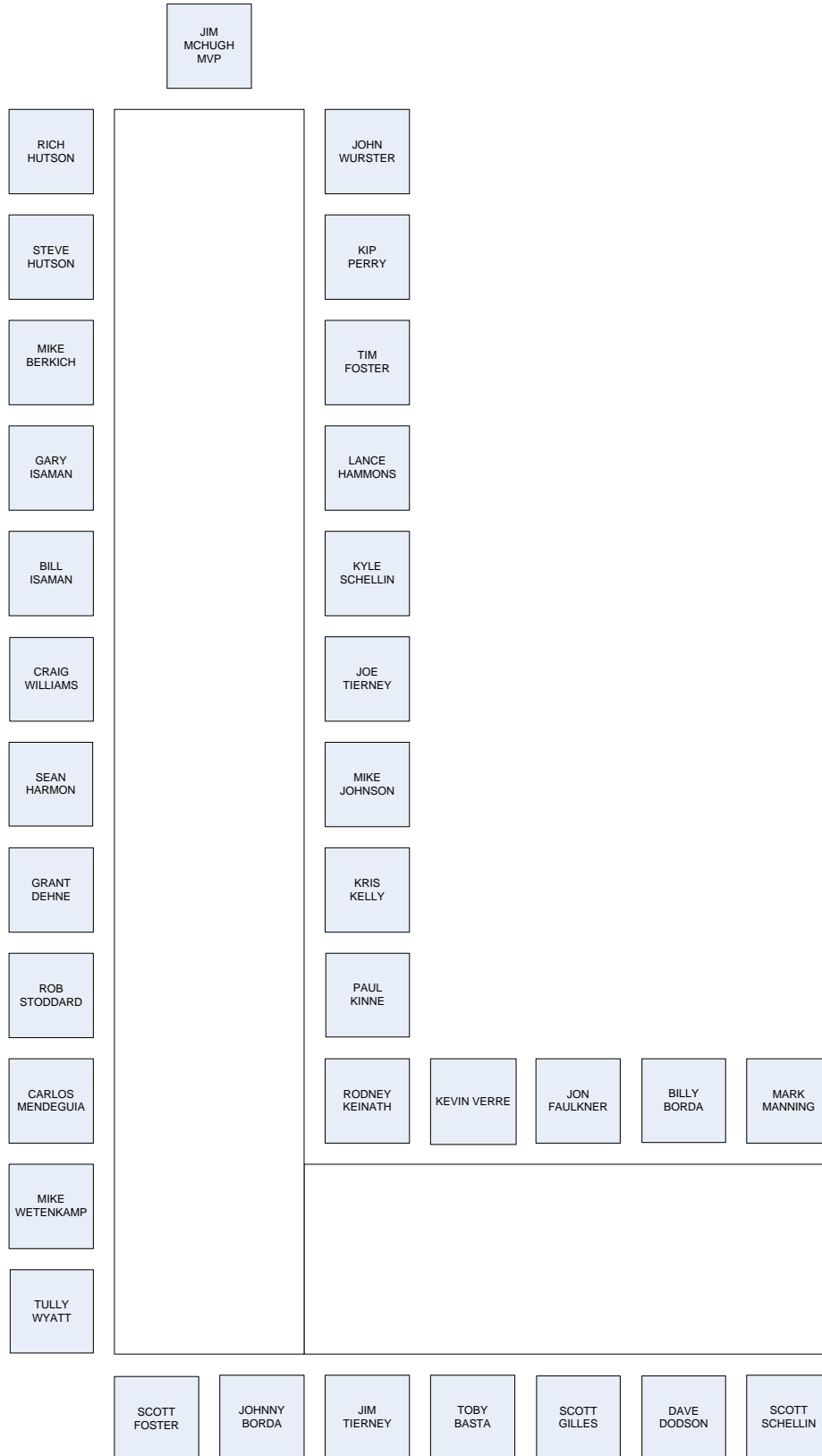
Player Conduct/Other Information

- A bags player/team while in competition shall make no disturbing noises or movements that would distract the opponent or players on surrounding courts. Other inappropriate behavior would include profanity, abusive language, obscene gestures, flipping bags, etc.
- Any bags player who indulges in heckling or unfair rooting, uses profanity or abusive language, makes obscene gestures, or exhibits any other form of un-sportsmanlike conduct toward other players, Designated Officials, or others who are in the area of the courts, shall be subject to expulsion from the Tournament/Event and from the event site.
- Shirts cannot be sleeveless; cut-offs are not permitted
- Venue permitting, players can drink alcoholic beverages while playing, but drinks must be placed outside the live court area, in a safe zone, or on a drink stand/holder.
- The use of alcohol or any form of tobacco while in the confines of the courts may be prohibited for all contestants, officials, and scorekeepers at the discretion of the Sierra Nevada Classic Commission.
- The use of audio and visual equipment in the confines of the event premises may be used by the Sierra Nevada Classic Commission. Your presence in the filming/photography area constitutes consent to be recorded/photographed.

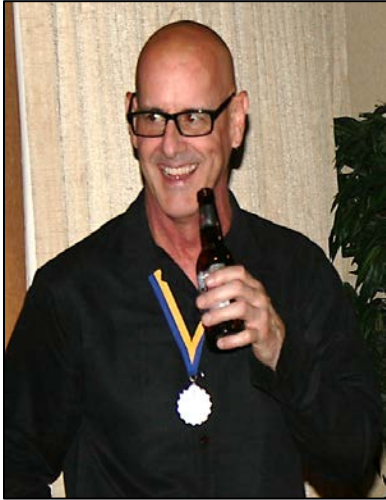
