Scramble Rules

Method of play and rules:

1. Play begins with each member of the group teeing off.
2. With the agreement of the other members of the group, the team captain decides which drive is the most desirable.
3. The other members of the group pick up their balls and proceed to the spot of the selected drive, where they will hit their second (or third, or fourth, etc. shot).
4. After the shot, all balls may be placed within one club length of the original ball. This may be done either to the side or backwards. Balls may not be placed closer to the hole.
5. In placing the ball, you may not change the condition of the shot. If the ball is in a hazard (e.g. sand trap, rough) all members of the team must play their shot from the trap or rough, respectively.
6. This procedure continues until the ball is in the hole.
7. On the putting green, **do not hole out a short putt if you have missed your first putt.** The first ball putted must count. Mark your ball and wait. If the second or third putt is better, mark that putt. Under no circumstances will there be any gimmies.
8. At the end of each hole, the score for the group is recorded on the card.
9. All scorecards must be kept accurately and per hole.
10. Each player on the team must contribute at least **two** tee shots per 18 holes. If only three members are on a team, **three** tee shots must be used per 18 holes. When recording your score on the card, you must input which player's tee shot was used on every hole. Also mark down which member of your team made the putt.
11. The maximum score allowed is a double-par. After that, simply pick up the balls and move on to the next hole.
12. In case of tiebreaker after 18 holes, playoff rules for winner will be based on golf course availability and/or agreement between applicable captains on tiebreaker procedures.



SNC Horseshoe Tournament Rules

Method of play and rules:

1. All court layout dimensions, playing equipment and scoring will follow the official rules sanctioned by the NHPA (National Horseshoe Pitchers Association of America).
2. Cancellation scoring will be used to keep score during the tournament.
3. Ringer: Ringers cancel each other. A ringer of one contestant shall cancel a ringer of another contestant and those shoes shall not score any points. Any uncanceled (live) ringers shall score 3 points.
4. Shoes in Count: A shoe in count (upright horseshoe length from the stake) shall score one point under the following conditions: If there are cancelled ringers and no live ringer, the closest shoe in count to the stake shall score one point. If there are no ringers, the closest shoe in count to the stake shall score one point. If the other shoe of the same contestant is the second closest shoe in count, it shall also score one point. If there is one uncanceled ringer and the other shoe of the scoring contestant is the closest shoe in count to the stake, it shall score one point (four points total).
5. On tournament day, there will be one scorekeeper per game. This score sheet shall be the official record of the game. Contestants are encouraged to pay close attention to the score at all times. If a question or discrepancy occurs regarding the score, the contestant(s) may approach the scorekeeper between innings to rectify the situation. This scorekeeper or other identified authority will also judge any discrepancy of which contestants shoes are closer to the stakes during the game. If discrepancies cannot be corrected to the satisfaction of all contestants, the tournament judge shall be called in to make the final decision.
6. Each team will be comprised of four pitchers. Each team will be selected into an eight team bracket that will be drawn on seeding night.
7. The Horseshoe Tournament will begin with your team dividing into two teams of two contestants. **(These teams must be determined before seeding)**. Your two teams will be matched against the other team in your bracket who will also divide their team into two teams of two contestants.
8. Please note that your "A" squad will match up with your opponents "A" squad along with "B" squad vs. "B" squad in your individual bracket. If both of your split squads win, you advance out of bracket. If one squad loses and the other wins, only the winning squad can participate in the tie breaker to advance to the next round. Also, the bottom team in the bracket will call the coin toss and be able to choose individual match ups within the bracket. There will again be a coin flip in case of a tie breaker.
9. Each game will be played to twenty-one points (First team to twenty-one, no need to win by two points). However, the skunk rule will be in effect. If any team scores eleven points before their opponent scores one point, the game is over. Final score would be (11-0).
10. The Sierra Nevada Athletic Commission will allow alcohol, smoking and chewing during this tournament event.



SNC Bowling Tournament Rules

Method of play and rules:

1. Teams will begin round one play based on Thursday night bracket seeding.
2. The teams that win in the first round will advance to the second round and either the title or consolation games via match play.
3. If two teams are tied at the end of 10 frames of bowling, the Captains from each team will bowl against each other frame by frame until there is a winner.

Overall Tournament Scoring Rules

1 st Place In An Individual Event.....	4 Points
2 nd Place In An Individual Event.....	3 Points
3 rd Place In An Individual Event.....	2 Points
4 th Place In An Individual Event.....	1 Point

Tiebreaker

If the day ends with a tie for first place in the overall tournament, a bowl-off will be implemented to determine the champion. Then, in order to determine the overall finish other than first, total points and then total bowling average will be used to rank teams.

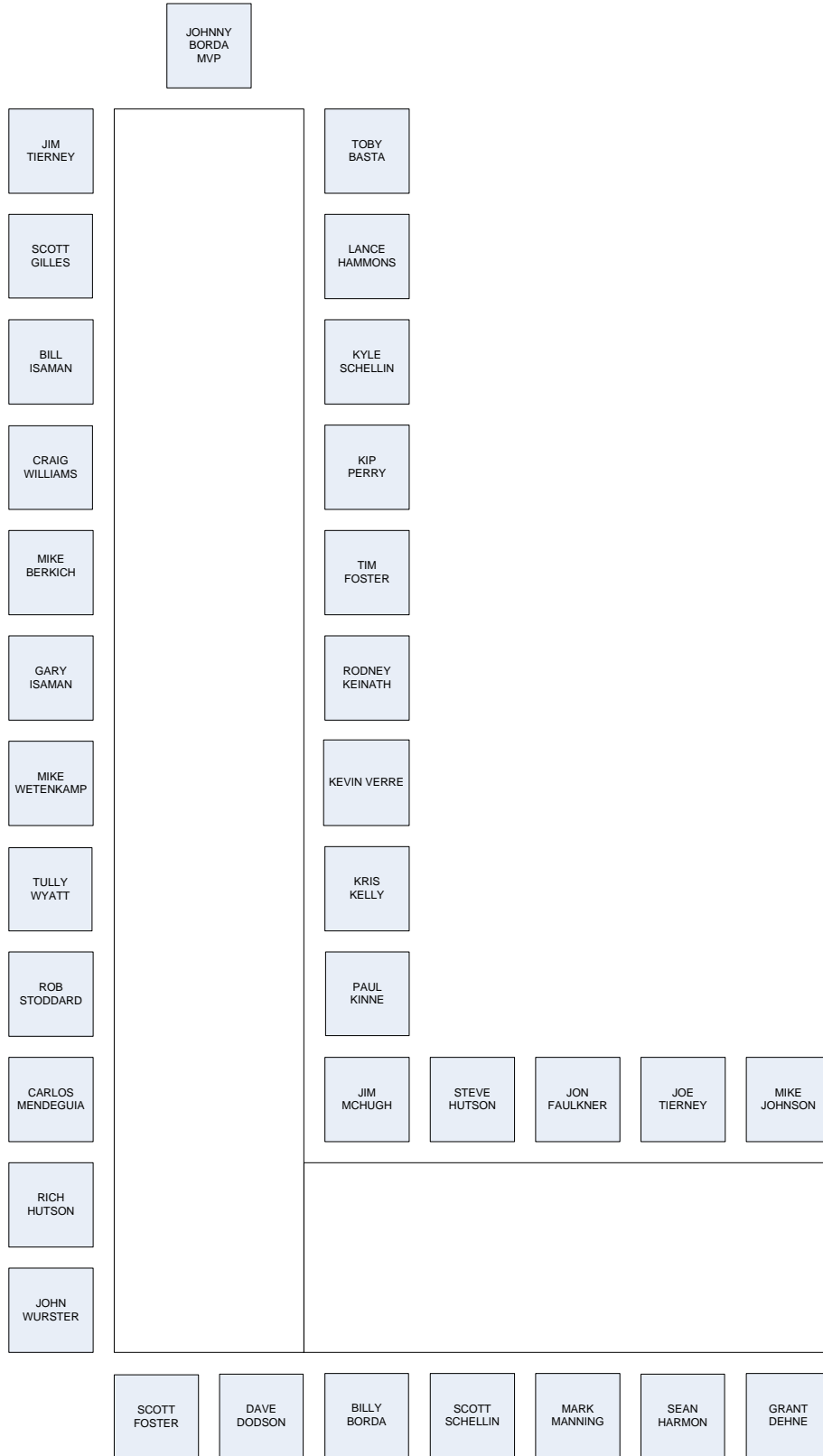

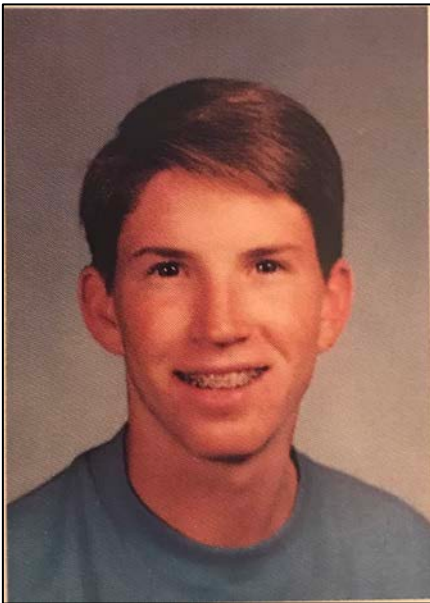

2018 Sierra Nevada Classic – Champions (1st Place Golf, 2nd Place Bowling)

After a dismal 2017 finish, one of the worst in Let It Ride history, the Commissioner predicted a 6th place finish for the Let It Ride 2018 team and no one was second guessing that prediction. No one except Let It Ride, that is. Fueled by an off-season print out of the 2108 Media Guide pinned to every member of LIR's bulletin board, they came first off the tee box at Genoa and never looked back. After starting with a par on hole number one, they birdied the next two holes and led for the rest of the round. Ten birdies, one eagle and an all-time SNC record of 60 later, Let It Ride went into day two with their 2nd ever golf championship, 4 points and an optimistic outlook. Next up was Fistful of \$\$\$ and they had a great shot to slam the door on Let It Ride's chances, but Let It Ride didn't fold like normal and won the final frame giving them their first ever trophy and a shit load of smiles.

2018 Sierra Nevada Classic – 2nd Place (3rd Place Golf, 1st Place Horseshoes)

As SNC 23 started, Stage Fright was beaming with confidence in ultra-tight fitting new uniforms. On the links, Leroy led the way, finding the fairway 6 times, putting the team in position for a share of second place at the turn. Da Whala downed several quad adult beverages mixed with little to no fillers and 99.99% vodka, and again delivered with 6 solid drives. Captain Yeti and Lurch took advantage of birdie putts as they hacked up the fairways, as Stage Fright battled to a reputable 66, and a 3 way tie for second place. But after another playoff loss, this time to the smooth operator, Special K and the Point Shavers, Stage Fright walked away from the links frustrated with a missed opportunity and a third place finish in golf. The Achilles heel for Stage Fright in the modern era of the SNC has undoubtedly been horseshoes and they again drew a formidable opponent in Powell's Brickyard for the second straight year, but history would not repeat itself for Captain Yeti and Da Whala as they narrowly escaped a hard fought match with Casanova and Southie en route to a 21-19 W. Leroy and Lurch also brought their A game with an 11-0 skunk sending Sleepy and Chef to early naps. Next up The Penetrators, where Greez and Paw were caught comparing hairlines with their pants down as Da Whala and Yeti paved the way to the upset. Stage Fright would split but ultimately win in the grudge match. Now in unfamiliar territory, Stage Fright took down Full House in unconventional fashion as Leroy and Lurch won both of their matches to take their first ever horseshoe title. With 6 points heading into lunch, Stage Fright had set the table for the championship and only needed a 3rd place finish in bowling to take home the first title in franchise history. With Let It Ride first up, Stage Fright liked their chances. Captain Yeti led the way with an opening round 191 and No. 1 draft pick Da Whala followed suit with a solid 141 as Stage Fright looked to be in cruise control. But it wasn't meant to be as Lurch and Leroy found themselves outmatched by the surprising carney skills of Uncle Nightmare and the Serb who were up to their old tricks from their juvie days. Just like that, in a fleeting moment, with their hands all but gripping the trophy, Stage Fright's title hopes were dashed. Sigh, boys. Sigh.

Their Pace of Play was Patient and by no means Painful, but the early Pressure Packed a Punch and they could not Pass the rest of the Pack. The Pasty Flame and Persistent Paw could not carry the other Paltry Performers, and the Philosophy of Positivity and Puffs of Pot did not Prevail. On the Horseshoe Pitch, they found their way to the Preposterous Position of Playing lots of games for the Lowest Possible scoring Prize: a single Point. More Prior Preparation before the once-Per-year tourney in the Horseshoe Pits for these Players will result in a higher PG Avg. and Pay off come Saturday P.M. The high Percentage of shoes that clip the grass Patch is a Pattern that must live in the Past. Their Persistence in Bowling is Plainly a Portion of their success, but due to the Passion from the competition's Players, Pummeling Pins would not be the Primary Prescription that will Propel them back to the Pinnacle.

Comment from Cap'n Greez: "Chemistry continues to be really good with this squad. But it seems chemistry ain't arithmetic since lately chemistry doesn't seem to be adding up to more hardware in the trophy case. 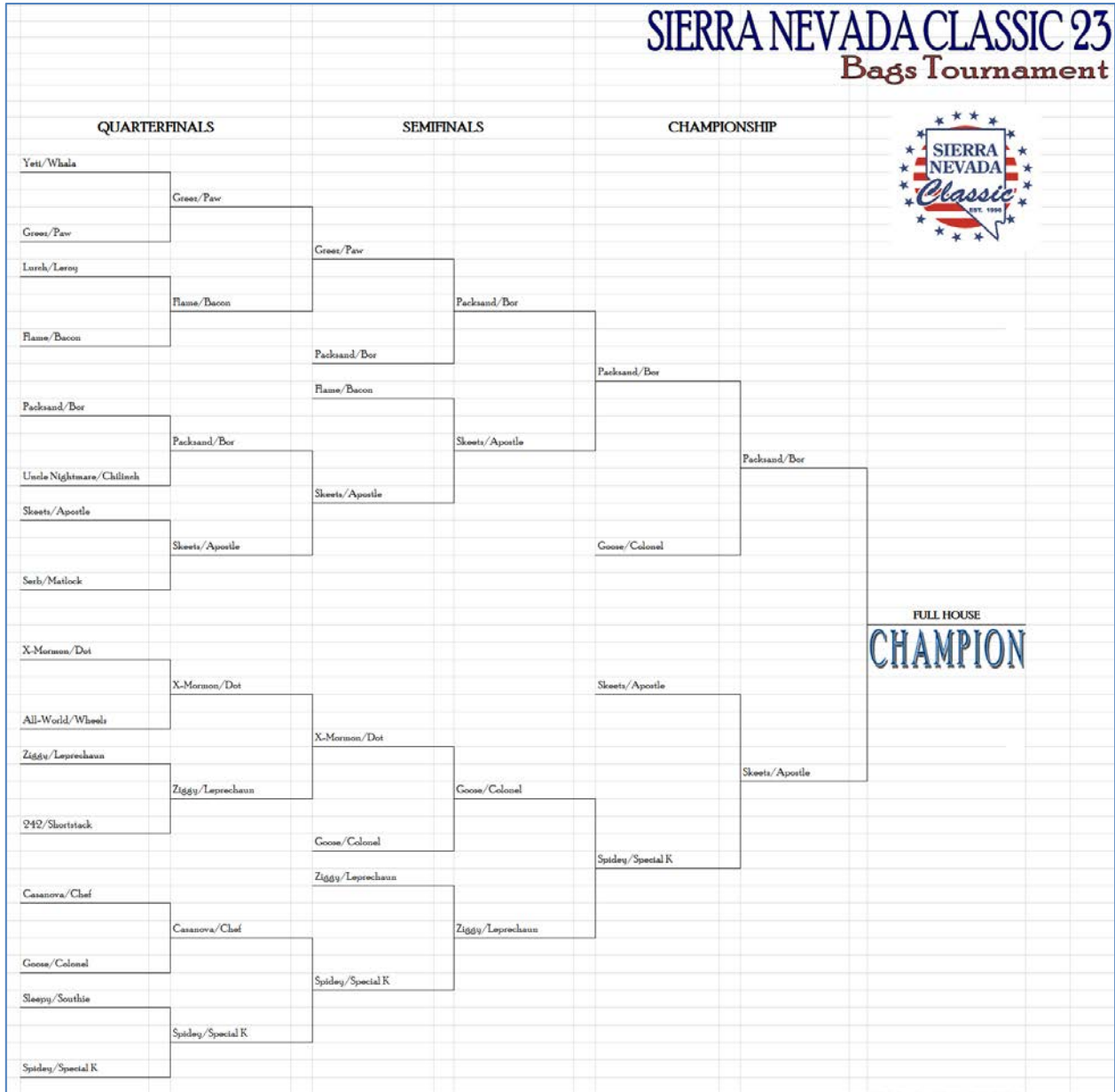
