## #13 Rodney "Spiderman" Keinath

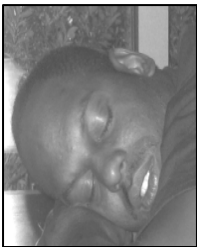

## #23 Kevin “Special K” Verre

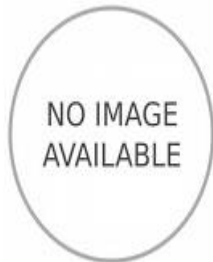
