SNC Golf Scramble Rules

Method of play and rules:

- 1. Play begins with each member of the group teeing off.
- 2. With the agreement of the other members of the group, the team captain decides which drive is the most desirable.
- 3. The other members of the group pick up their balls and proceed to the spot of the selected drive, where they will hit their second (or third, or fourth, etc. shot).
- 4. After the shot, all balls may be placed within one club length of the original ball. This may be done either to the side or backwards. Balls may not be placed closer to the hole.
- 5. In placing the ball, you may not change the condition of the shot. If the ball is in a hazard (e.g. sand trap, rough) all members of the team must play their shot from the trap or rough, respectively.
- 6. This procedure continues until the ball is in the hole.
- 7. On the putting green, **do not hole out a short putt if you have missed your first putt.** The first ball putted must count. Mark your ball and wait. If the second or third putt is better, mark that putt. Under no circumstances will there be any gimmies.
- 8. At the end of each hole, the score for the group is recorded on the card.
- 9. All scorecards must be kept accurately and per hole.
- 10. Each player on the team must contribute at least **two** tee shots per 18 holes. If only three members are on a team, **three** tee shots must be used per 18 holes. When recording your score on the card, you must input which player's tee shot was used on every hole. Also mark down which member of your team made the putt.
- 11. The maximum score allowed is a double-par. After that, simply pick up the balls and move on to the next hole.
- 12. In case of tiebreaker after 18 holes, playoff rules for winner will be based on golf course availability and/or agreement between applicable captains on tiebreaker procedures.



SNC Horseshoe Tournament Rules

Method of play and rules:

- 1. All court layout dimensions, playing equipment and scoring will follow the official rules sanctioned by the NHPA (National Horseshoe Pitchers Association of America).
- 2. Cancellation scoring will be used to keep score during the tournament.
- 3. Ringer: Ringers cancel each other. A ringer of one contestant shall cancel a ringer of another contestant and those shoes shall not score any points. Any uncancelled (live) ringers shall score 3 points.
- 4. Shoes in Count: A shoe in count (upright horseshoe length from the stake) shall score one point under the following conditions: If there are cancelled ringers and no live ringer, the closest shoe in count to the stake shall score one point. If there are no ringers, the closest shoe in count to the stake shall score one point. If the other shoe of the same contestant is the second closest shoe in count, it shall also score one point. If there is one uncancelled ringer and the other shoe of the scoring contestant is the closest shoe in count to the stake, it shall score one point (four points total).
- 5. On tournament day, there will be one scorekeeper per game. This score sheet shall be the official record of the game. Contestants are encouraged to pay close attention to the score at all times. If a question or discrepancy occurs regarding the score, the contestant(s) may approach the scorekeeper between innings to rectify the situation. This scorekeeper or other identified authority will also judge any discrepancy of which contestants shoes are closer to the stakes during the game. If discrepancies cannot be corrected to the satisfaction of all contestants, the tournament judge shall be called in to make the final decision.
- 6. Each team will be comprised of four pitchers. Each team will be selected into an eight team bracket that will be drawn on seeding night.
- 7. The Horseshoe Tournament will begin with your team dividing into two teams of two contestants. (These teams must be determined before seeding). Your two teams will be matched against the other team in your bracket who will also divide their team into two teams of two contestants.
- 8. Please note that your "A" squad will match up with your opponents "A" squad along with "B" squad vs. "B" squad in your individual bracket. If both of your split squads win, you advance out of bracket. If one squad loses and the other wins, only the winning squad can participate in the tie breaker to advance to the next round. Also, the bottom team in the bracket will call the coin toss and be able to choose individual match ups within the bracket. There will again be a coin flip in case of a tie breaker.
- 9. Each game will be played to twenty-one points (First team to twenty-one, no need to win by two points). However, the skunk rule will be in effect. If any team scores eleven points before their opponent scores one point, the game is over. Final score would be (11-0).
- 10. The Sierra Nevada Athletic Commission will allow alcohol, smoking and chewing during this tournament event.



SNC Bowling Tournament Rules

Method of play and rules:

- 1. Teams will begin round one play based on Thursday night bracket seeding.
- 2. The teams that win in the first round will advance to the second round and either the title or consolation games via match play.
- 3. If two teams are tied at the end of 10 frames of bowling, the Captains from each team will bowl against each other frame by frame until there is a winner.

1 st Place In An Individual Event	.4 Points
2 nd Place In An Individual Event	3 Points
3 rd Place In An Individual Event.	2 Points
4 th Place In An Individual Event	1 Point

Tiebreaker

If the day ends with a tie for first place in the overall tournament, a bowl-off will be implemented to determine the champion. Then, in order to determine the overall finish other than first, total points and then total bowling average will be used to rank teams.



2016 Sierra Nevada Classic – Champions (1st Place Golf, 2nd Place Horseshoes, 1st Place Bowling)

For the second year in a row, the Penetrators came into the Classic a man down since Bacon was once again scouring the backwoods of Elko and hospital dumpsters for food scraps to fatten up his skinny pigs. A gray cloud hung over the squad as uncertainty dominated the team's discussions. Then came the announcement that an offspring of Bacon's, Garet "Sizzlean" Isaman, would be, as it was in the 1980s, the substitute for Bacon. The previous year's last place finish in golf was soon a distant memory as 5 birdies and a dramatic eagle on 18 placed the Penetrators at the top of the golf totem pole for the first time in Classic history, thanks to key strokes by the rookie, no snap hooks from Paw, typical drives from Flame and the experienced cart navigating of Greez. Going into Day 2, any points in horseshoes would put them in prime position with a legit shot at another title. After taking advantage of Full House being a man down and winning the third game after a split, the Penetrators took both games in the semis from Let It Ride, 21-9 and 21-15, to set up a showdown with the Colt .45s. The hopes of a first-place finish in 'shoes were quickly dashed however by a pasting at the hands of the .45s. On to the lanes, typically a strong event for the Penetrators. The pesky competitiveness of all squads in the Classic and the effects of half time on the rookie could have easily cost this team a victory despite its point tally. Let It Ride's strong showing pushed them to their limits in the opening round, but they advanced thanks to soon-to-be MVP Paw's 186. Not a strong math squad, they weren't sure if they had it locked up or not, so they had to focus on Stage Fright. Despite Sizzlean wandering the alley in between shots while shedding tears in appreciation for his participation in the Classic, Flame's 212 ensured the team made the bowling finals. Revenge for the horseshoe final was on their minds as they took down the Colt .45s by 35 pins, with Paw once again having the game high, a 177. With that, a Classic tying sixth

With him back we expect to be in the mix come late Saturday despite his lack of abs. Our approach to the Classic will be what it always has been, to look forward to hanging with awesome friends and to enjoy the long weekend of activities while maintaining a competitive focus throughout."

SNC 21 was yet another glaring example of just how volatile and unsettling the Colt .45s can be. True to history, their free-swinging shotgun approach on the links scared nobody, as they managed only one birdie on the day and decisively secured another last place finish; proving that you can't ride a Shortstack to scoring unless you have nice breasts and a sweet voice. But almost as automatic as their ineptitude in golf, is their ferocity on the steel stakes. Day two produced a clean sweep in the pits, with 28 team ringers and an average margin of victory of 9 points. Beginning with a modest win over Powell's Brickyard in the first round, Colt .45s made whipped cream of second round shoesters, Stage Fright, and continued the bludgeoning over tourney nemesis, the Penetrators, in the finals to take their 6th horseshoes title and keep the fate of The Classic undetermined until after lunch. Standing at 4 points and the Penetrators at 7, the only way to secure a 3rd SNC Championship in four years would be to take first place in bowling and hope for an early stumble by the Penetrators. Wouldn't happen. Although the Colt .45s pieced together a few victories, their pedestrian performance in the finals against the Penetrators left them with a second place finish in bowling, and a respectable, but less than pleasing second place overall finish in SNC 21.

Let It Ride came into SNC 21 at their fighting weight and looked ready to rumble and take their first title. As they laced up their golf cleats they looked like the team to beat, but then they bogeyed the second hole. Yet, there was no worry as they then rolled off 6 birdies including a huge one on 18 to leave them a stroke up for the lead with both Stage Fright and The Penetrators needing to birdie 18 to force a playoff. Stage Fright was first and they couldn't get it done as they got a par and Let It Ride was in the driver's seat as The Penetrators needed a bird to force a playoff. But The Penetrators didn't get the bird, they got the improbable eagle as they stole the golf title from under Let It Ride's noses and Let It Ride shuffled off of Genoa Lakes shaking their heads in disbelief. Seemingly with a chip on their shoulders, Let It Ride strolled onto the horseshoe pits where they have had very limited success in the past, and put it on Fistful with an A-Squad Chilinch/Gilles drubbing of 23 – 9 and a B-Squad JB/Serb annihilation via the skunk 12 – 0. Facing the SNC bowling juggernaut Penetrators, Let It Ride knew they had to beat the best to be the best and they didn't back down from the challenge as they bowled a collective +53 over their normal average, but even with a 78 from the rookie Sizzlean and a well below average 165 from Flame, they couldn't overcome Paw's 186 as the Penetrators had their number an


